YMCA INDIAN STUDENT HOSTEL, London

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR LONG TERM RESIDENTS

- 1. **Residence:** Residence is offered to members only and generally for a period of six weeks to six months. Any extension beyond this period is left to the discretion of the Management. A trainee/executive shall agree to stay a minimum period of **six weeks** to qualify for the long-term concessional rent, while a full time student shall agree to stay a minimum period of **six months** to avail student concession.
- 2. **Admission Fee:** An admission fee of £35 is payable at the time of admission(non refundable).
- 3. **Membership Fees:** The membership fee is payable at the time of admission to the hostel, valid for a year.
- 4. **Termination of Residence:** A resident must vacate his/her room at once upon request by the General Secretary or his authorised representative. Any balance dues to him/her shall be refunded.
- 5. **Hostel Rent:** Resident members are required to pay fees monthly in advance by the SEVENTH day of each month, if not from the **EIGHT** day a late fee of £5.00 per day will be added to the fee till the end of the **TWELETH** day of the month and thereafter £10.00 per day. Payment should be made during office hours which will be specified on the notice board.

Hostel Rent will be reviewed on the 1st of September each year.

- 6. **Membership Fees** to be paid on an annual basis. All overseas membership cards will be considered valid for the current year only.
- 7. **Security Deposit & Key Deposit:** A security deposit of £350 and a key deposit of £25 is payable at the time of admission. This will be refunded at the time of vacating the hostel.
- 8. **Extension: FOUR WEEKS** advance written request must be made for any extension of stay, the granting of which is entirely at the discretion of the management.
- 9. **Vacating The Hostel:** Ten Days written notice of the departure of long-term resident members is required. Students vacating the hostel on their own accord before completion of the required minimum period of stay of **six months** are liable to pay hostel fees as applicable to trainees or transit residents in accordance with their effective period of stay in the hostel. The trainees vacating the hostel seat earlier than the allocated period are liable to pay hostel fees as per transit rate.
- 10. **Checking Out Time:** This will be 10:00 am on the day of departure.

- Dress Code: Residents are expected to come to the Dining Hall in proper attire. (Please avoid using shorts, lungies and night dresses)
- No food should be taken to the rooms, except in the case of illness, with the General Secretary/Assistant General Secretary/ Assistant Secretary's permission.

- Late dinners, (Monday to Friday) may be provided to a limited number of residents for academic reasons only and on production of a letter/document to that effect. Dinner will be served in foil containers which could be collected after 9:00 pm from the reception desk.
- No crockery or cutlery should be taken out of the Dining Hall, and if found in the rooms, will attract a
 fine.
- **Food Rebate**: You may be entitled to have Food rebate only if you are away from YMCA for a minimum period of one week.
- 12. **Visitors:** The hostel floors are restricted to residents only. Visitors including past residents may be received in the Reception Lounge only up to 10:30pm. Non-resident members, guests and visitors are not permitted to remain on the premises after 10:30pm. No non-resident is allowed to stay overnight. Visitors and the hosts are required to sign the visitor's book kept at the Reception.
- 13. **Guest Stay:** Guest can stay overnight with prior approval of the Management. Male residents are not allowed to have female guest and female residents are not allowed to have male guests in the rooms. However, the blood relatives may be allowed to stay subject to submission of proof of relation.
- 14. **Visiting Rooms:** Male residents are not permitted to visit the Ladies rooms and vice versa at any time.
- 15. **Late Arrivals:** Residents likely to arrive late (Trainees/Students) should inform the General Secretary/Assistant General Secretary well in advance at least by 12 noon on the same day. However, if one works late night he/she should produce relevant documents and obtain prior approval. One will also need permission to attend late night functions and events. One may communicate to the General Secretary or Assistant General Secretary by email or text.
- 16. **Entry To The Living Area:** Residents are provided individual keys to enter the hostel living area. Please use your keys for this purpose carefully.
- 17. **Quiet Hours:** Residents are expected to consider the well-being of others and to this end, are specially asked to make no noise between 11:00pm and 7:30am.
- 18. **Opening And Closing Hours:** The main entrance of the hostel will remain locked from 11:30pm to 7.00am, Monday to Thursday and 12:00am to 7:00am from Friday to Sunday. Those returning after closing time are required to sign the late register at the Reception. Frequent late arrival is not permitted.
- 19. **Illness:** Illness should be reported at once to the General Secretary/Assistant General Secretary/Assistant Secretary. All residents are required to register individually with a doctor under the National Health Scheme.
- 20. **Laundary Room:** Washing of clothes is permitted in the laundry rooms situated on the third floor for men and the lower ground floor for the women. Clothes should not be washed or left to dry in residents rooms. The facilities for ironing clothes are provided in the corridors. The facilities in the laundry rooms are restricted for the use of the resident members only. The time for the last wash is 9:30pm.
- 21. **Forwarding Address:** Any resident staying away overnight should inform the General Secretary/Assistant General Secretary and leave the address or telephone number at which the resident can be contacted. Those vacating the hostel are advised to leave their forwarding address in the leaving register, provided at the Reception.
- 22. **Loss:** While all reasonable care will be exercised to safeguard a resident's property, no responsibility is accepted by the Management for damage or loss however caused. Residents are advised to insure their personal belongings.

- 23. **Right of Entry to Rooms:** The General Secretary/Assistant General Secretary have the right of entry to any rooms at any time for any reasonable purpose.
- 24. Room Cleaning: Cleaning rooms and making beds is carried out by cleaning staff, but residents are asked to keep their rooms neat and tidy. Cleaning is done on alternate days and linen is changed once a week. Residents are asked to make their own beds on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays, when the staff are not available.

25. Prohibitions:

- Gambling, Drugs and consumption of intoxicating drinks are prohibited in the YMCA premises.
- Alteration or addition to light, fixtures, and fittings of furnishing is prohibited. Such usage is dangerous and may result in fire, causing damage to person and property.
- Storage of paraffin, explosives or petrol in any part of the building or the use of electric fires or cookers and other heating apparatus is prohibited.
- Throwing or hanging things out of the window is prohibited. Hence, residents shall refrain from hanging things out of the window. Litter bins provided in the rooms or elsewhere on the premises must be used.
- Change of room without permission is forbidden.
- **Penalty:** The cost of damage caused to the property and belongings of the YMCA must be met by the resident.
- **Electrical items:** Electrical equipments such as refrigerator, cookers, ovens, electric iron and television sets are forbidden from being used in the rooms. However, computers, printers and music systems of 5watts may be used. The management has the right to remove any forbidden items found in the rooms.
- Parties & Gatherings: Unauthorised gatherings in rooms for any form of celebration are strictly not permitted in any part of the building premises.
- Save Fuel, Energy & Water A valuable world resource: Help us to save fuel and energy whenever possible. Please switch off lights when you are not in your room and ensure taps are closed, not leaving any water to drip. Use water carefully.
- Nails, screws, tapes and adhesives should not be used on walls for all your needs. Use only boards provided. No posters of any sort are permitted.

• Baggage/Luggage: Excess Luggage must be kept in the Cloak Room on charges for using this facility Personal Baggage/Luggage must not be kept with anyone else.
